Show or hide the bookmarks bar. If the bar is hidden, you can see your bookmarks in the Chrome menu.	<b>Ctrl + Shift + B</b>
Open the Files app	<b>Alt + Shift + M</b>
Display hidden files in the Files app	<b>Ctrl + .</b>
Open the History page	<b>Ctrl + H</b>
Open the Downloads page	<b>Ctrl + J</b>
Open the Task Manager	<b>Search + Esc</b>
Open or hide the list of available keyboard shortcuts	<b>Ctrl + Alt + /</b>
Get help with your Chromebook	<b>Ctrl + ?</b>
Configure monitor display	<b>Ctrl + </b>
Open the status area in the bottom-right corner of the screen	<b>Shift + Alt + S</b>
Highlight the launcher button on your shelf	<b>Shift + Alt + L</b>
Highlight the next item on your shelf	<b>Shift + Alt + L, then Tab or right arrow</b>
Highlight the previous item on your shelf	<b>Shift + Alt + L, then Shift + Tab or left arrow</b>
Open the highlighted button on your shelf	<b>Shift + Alt + L, then Space or Enter</b>
Remove the highlight from a button on your shelf	<b>Shift + Alt + L, then Esc</b>
Switch focus to the next keyboard-accessible pane. Panes include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Status area containing the time, network icon, and battery icon</li><li>• Launcher</li><li>• Address bar</li><li>• Bookmarks bar (if visible)</li><li>• The main web content (including any infobars)</li><li>• Downloads bar (if visible)</li></ul>	<b>Ctrl +  or Ctrl + </b>
Highlight the bookmarks bar (if shown)	<b>Alt + Shift + B</b>
Highlight the row with the address bar	<b>Shift + Alt + T</b>
Open the Chrome menu on the browser toolbar	<b>Alt + E or Alt + F</b>
Open right-click menus for highlighted items	<b>Shift + Search + Volume Up</b>
Turn <a href="#">ChromeVox</a>  (spoken feedback) on or off	<b>Ctrl + Alt + Z</b>
Change screen resolution	<b>Ctrl + Shift and + or -</b>
Reset screen resolution to default	<b>Ctrl + Shift and 0</b>
Rotate screen 90 degrees	<b>Ctrl + Shift and Reload</b>
